**ORDER ADMITTING NEW EXHIBITS INTO EVIDENCE**

The hearing in the above-captioned case was held in Oakland, California, on March 9 2020. During the course of the hearing, it was revealed that Respondent Hennes & Mauritz, LP d/b/a H&M, due to technical difficulties, had been unable to produce some documents that had been subpoenaed by the General Counsel. Nonetheless, Respondent gave assurances that said documents could be retrieved and would be turned over to the General Counsel in about a week's time. I instructed the General Counsel that when such documents were received, a motion should be made to admit into evidence any such documents that the General Counsel deemed to be relevant, or, in the alternative, to make a motion to re-open the hearing to obtain further testimony should that be necessary. On March 19, 2020, the General Counsel, having received the aforesaid documents from Respondent, made a motion to admit into the record General Counsel Exhibits 9 through 13, indicating that Respondent was not opposed to their admission into the record.

Accordingly, and in light of the above, the motion to admit General Counsel Exhibits 9-13, is granted. The General Counsel shall notify the Reporting Service of this Order and provide them with a copy of General Counsel Exhibits 9 through 13 so that these exhibits can be incorporated into the record, both in hardcopy (paper) form as well as in electronic form.
