Dear Madam Executive Secretary:

This letter is being filed on behalf of Prospect Crozer, LLC d/b/a Crozer-Chester Medical Center (the “Employer”) in the above-referenced matter. On April 7, 2020, the Employer filed a Request for Review of the Acting Regional Director, Region 4’s Decision and Direction of Election. The Employer requested expedited consideration of its Request for Review and further asked that the Board stay the election.

In Section I of its Request for Review, at page 3, the Employer wrote, “[a]s of the filing of this Request for Review, an election has not been set.” That statement is incorrect and the result of a drafting error, due to the issuance of the Acting Regional Director’s Order granting the Petitioner’s request for a mail ballot election on April 7, 2020, shortly before the Employer filed its Request for Review. As the Employer noted in its Request for Review in Section V, at pages 19-20, the Acting Regional Director has ordered a mail ballot election over the Employer’s objection. Ballots are being mailed to voters one week from today, on April 21, 2020.

Please treat this letter as a correction of the above-mentioned inadvertent misstatement in the Employer’s Request for Review, as well as a renewal of the Employer’s request that the Board stay the election pending review in this matter.
