**ORDER (1) GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO REMAND
CERTAIN COMPLAINT ALLEGATIONS TO THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR AND
(2) REMANDING SUCH COMPLAINT ALLEGATIONS TO REGIONAL DIRECTOR**

On March 31, 2020, Counsel for the General Counsel filed a Motion to Remand Certain Complaint Allegations to the Regional Director (Motion to Remand), pursuant to Section 102.24 of the Board's Rules and Regulations, in light of the Board's decision in *The Boeing Company*, 365 NLRB No. 154 (2017). The allegations sought to be remanded are set forth at paragraphs 4(4), 4(8) and 4(10) of the Complaint in this matter.

In support of the Motion to Remand, Counsel for the General Counsel states that Charging Party International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, District Council 15, Local 159, AFL-CIO on January 23, 2018, submitted a request to the Regional Director for Region 28 seeking to withdraw the charges related to Complaint paragraphs 4(4), 4(8) and 4(10). On April 1, 2020, I issued an Order to Show Cause as to why the Motion to Remand should not be granted. No party responded to that order; accordingly, the Motion to Remand is unopposed.

Based on the foregoing, I find that it would effectuate the policies of the Act to grant the unopposed Motion to Remand and remand the allegations stated at paragraphs 4(4), 4(8) and 4(10) of the Complaint in this matter to the Regional Director for Region 28.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the General Counsel's unopposed Motion to Remand is **GRANTED**, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Complaint paragraphs 4(4), 4(8) and 4(10) are **REMANDED** to the Regional Director for Region 28 for further handling consistent with this Order.
