**MOTION TO VOLUNTARILY DISMISS THE PETITION FOR REVIEW**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 42(b), Petitioner International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees, Moving Picture Technicians, Artists and Allied Crafts of The United States, Its Territories and Canada, AFL-CIO, CLC (“IATSE”), by its counsel, respectfully moves the Court to voluntarily dismiss with prejudice the petition for review, and shows:

1. On December 6, 2019, IATSE filed with the Court a petition to review the Board’s Decision and Order in the above-captioned cases. (Dkt. No. 1.) Petitioner IATSE filed its brief on April 28, 2020. (Dkt. No. 76.) Respondent

National Labor Relations Board (“NLRB”) is to file its brief on or before July 21, 2020. (Dkt. No. 85.)

2. IATSE and Intervenor National Hot Rod Association (“NHRA”) have reached a resolution in this case that is satisfactory to those parties.

3. IATSE, therefore, requests that this Court dismiss with prejudice IATSE’s petition for review.

4. Each party is to bear its own costs.

5. Counsel for IATSE has consulted with counsel for the NLRB and the NHRA, and neither party objects to this motion.
