SUBJECT: Dates for Hearings and Statement/Restatement of Position Due Dates

As you know, Section 102.63(a) of the Board's Rules and Regulations provides that, except in cases presenting unusually complex issues, the pre-election hearing in RC, RD and RM cases will be scheduled for 14 business days from the date of service of the Notice of Representation Hearing. Section 102.1(i) defines "business day" as, "days that Agency offices are open normal business operating hours, which is Monday through Friday, excluding federal holidays. A list of federal holidays can be found at www.opm.gov/policy-data-oversight/snow-dismissal-procedures/federal-holidays/." Section 102.63(b) provides that the Statement of Position(s) will be due at noon 8 business days following the issuance and service of the Notice of Representation Hearing. Section 102.63(b) further provides that the Responsive Statements of Procedure(s) will be due at noon 3 business days before the hearing.

To assist Regions and the parties in determining the dates of hearings and the due dates for Statements of Position and Responsive Statements of Position, we have prepared the attached chart which sets forth the hearing dates and Statement of Position/Responsive Statement of Position due dates for RC, RD and RM petitions with dates of service from June 1, 2020 through May 28, 2021, that do not present unusually complex issues. The calculation of the due date is from the date the Notice of Representation Hearing is served, which in some instances will be later than the date the petition was filed.
