UNION’S OBJECTION TO EMPLOYER’S REQUEST TO POSTPONE HEARING

On principle, the Union objects to delays in the election process. Especially when the extensions are not justified. The Employer asks for 2 extra days to prepare its position, but was served with the RC petition on May 28, 2020. That means that--without any extension--the Employer will have 14 days to prepare its position statement. Two weeks is already more time than permitted by the election timelines set forth in the governing Regulations. 16 days is not justified.

The Union recognizes that the hotel is currently closed. If the Employer cannot make its witnesses available in time for Friday’s scheduled hearing, then the Union consents to a postponement of the hearing to next week, up to and including Tuesday, June 16.


