Counsel,

In view of the circumstances surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic, the Court wishes to advise the attorneys of record that oral argument in the cases scheduled to be heard during the week of August 24, 2020 in Montgomery, Alabama, will not be conducted in person.

Instead, the Court offers two options for attorneys who intend to orally argue any of those cases. They may:

- (1) File a motion to submit the case on the briefs, which the panel will give serious consideration, particularly if the motion is filed jointly¹, no later than August 14, 2020.
- (2) Participate in oral argument by audio conference from any location other than the courthouse.

The judges on the panel will conduct the oral argument proceedings and participate in them by audio. The usual order of arguments and time limits will apply.

Attorneys who are participating in an argument will be able to dial in by phone and enter an access code. The Clerk's Office, with the assistance of the Court's IT Department, will make the necessary arrangements and notify attorneys who will participate in the arguments of the technical details.
