

ORDER POSTPONING HEARING

The hearing in the above-captioned case is currently scheduled to begin telephonically at 9:00 a.m. on August 11, 2020, and to continue thereafter remotely via Zoom for Government. On August 3, 2020, Counsel for the Respondent filed a request for special permission to appeal my July 27, 2020, order to open the hearing telephonically and hold the hearing via Zoom to the National Labor Relations Board under Rule 102.26 of the Board's Rules and Regulations. Because the Respondent's request presents an important issue of first impression for the Board to consider, the hearing will not proceed as scheduled on August 11, 2020. Further proceedings in this matter are hereby postponed until the Board rules on the special appeal in this case or, in the alternative, issues a ruling in another unfair labor practices case in a manner that extends it to other pending cases.
