Dear Mr. Habenstreit,

On August 31, 2020, we received your Certified List docket event.

In light of the fact that both the Certified List and Administrative Record documents were improperly attached to the Certified List docket event, we are taking no action on the Certified List docket event, nor the documents attached thereto.

Counsel must choose from the following options:

1. Counsel may separately electronically file the Certified List docket event and upload only the Certified List document to that event; and then separately electronically file the Electronic Administrative Record Filed event and upload only the Administrative Record documents to that event;
2. Or, if counsel chooses to combine the Certified List and Administrative Record documents into 1 filing, then counsel must electronically file the Electronic Administrative Record Filed event. The Certified List & Administrative Record documents can both be attached to the Electronic Administrative Record Filed event. In doing so, the Administrative Record documents will be properly paginated by this Court's automated paginating system (**Note:** The Administrative Record documents are unable to be paginated when the documents are improperly attached to the Certified List event).

Because counsel attempted to timely file the Certified List & Administrative Record in this case, counsel's timeliness is persevered for 1 week. Meaning, counsel must take corrective action and properly file the Certified List & Administrative in accordance

with either of the above options. If corrective action is not taken by September 9, 2020, then a motion for leave to file the Certified List and Administrative Record out of time will be required.
