**MOTION OF THE NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD
TO EXPEDITE SETTLEMENT OF JUDGMENT**

To the Honorable, the Judges of the United States
Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit:

The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”), by its Assistant General Counsel, respectfully moves this Court to expedite the settlement of its judgment in the above-captioned case pursuant to Rules 19 and 27(f) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure. In support of this motion, the Board shows as follows:

1. On April 13, 2020, the Court issued its opinion granting in part the petition of Local 600, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement

Workers of America (UAW), AFL–CIO (“the Union”), and granting in part the Board’s cross-application for enforcement.

2. On April 21, 2020, in accordance with Rule 19 of the Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure, the Board filed with the Court a proposed judgment conforming to the opinion.

3. On April 23, 2020, the Union filed with the Court a proposed judgment that, in its view, conforms to the opinion.

4. On July 20, 2020, the Court issued a mandate pursuant to the Court’s April 13, 2020 disposition.

5. The Clerk’s office has informed the Board that the two proposed judgments remain pending before the panel of judges. Until the Court settles the judgment, the Board cannot ensure the Union’s compliance with the mandate. Accordingly, pursuant to Rule 27(f) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, the Board moves to expedite conclusion of the appeal by settlement of the judgment.

WHEREFORE, the Board respectfully requests that this Court settle the judgment and direct entry in this case.
