**ORDER GRANTING GENERAL COUNSEL'S  
MOTIONS TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINTS**

On December 12, 2019, the Board issued an Order Remanding in *McDonald's USA, LLC*, 368 NLRB No. 134, directing that the settlement agreements in the instant case be approved, and an order issued approving the settlement agreements on December 30, 2019. On January 7, 2020, Charging Parties filed a Motion to Reopen the Record and for Reconsideration, requesting that the Board reopen, reconsider, and reverse its December 12, 2019 Order Remanding. On January 15, 2020, Counsel for the General Counsel (General Counsel) filed motions requesting permission to withdraw all of the allegations against the Respondents in the instant case. On January 23, 2020, I issued an Order holding General Counsel's motions to withdraw the allegations in abeyance pending the Board's ruling on Charging Parties' Motion to Reopen the Record and for Reconsideration.

On September 16, 2020, the Board issued an Order Denying Charging Parties' Motion to Reopen the Record and for Reconsideration. By letter of September 30, 2020, General Counsel requested that the January 15, 2020 motions to withdraw the complaints be granted.

Accordingly, based upon the Board's December 12, 2019 Order Remanding and September 16, 2020 Order Denying Charging Parties' Motion to Reopen the Record, General Counsel's January 15, 2020 motions to withdraw the allegations in this matter are hereby granted.
