The National Labor Relations Board, by its Assistant General Counsel, respectfully moves this Court for a one-week extension of time, from October 13, 2020, to and including October 20, 2020, for filing the Board’s agency record, in the above matter, and shows:

1. On July 24, 2020, the Board issued its Decision and Order against Motor City Pawn Brokers, Inc., The Aubrey Group, Inc., and Aubrey Brothers, LLC, a single employer (the Respondent), which is reported at 369 NLRB No. 132.
2. On August 3, 2020, the Respondent filed a petition for review docketed as court no. 20-1730. The Board filed a cross-application for enforcement on September 1, 2020, docketed as court no. 20-1854.
3. The Board’s certified list was due to be filed on October 13, 2020.
