The following is before the Court: **NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD'S MOTION FOR AN ORDER LIQUIDATING THIS COURT'S FINES AND AWARD OF ATTORNEY'S FEES**, filed on October 13, 2020, by counsel for the petitioner.

On June 30, 2020, this court issued its order adjudicating Perkins Management Services Company ("Respondent") in civil contempt, and, further ordering, in relevant part, that "respondent is fined \$20,000. This fine will be forgiven if the respondent purges itself of the contempt and files a sworn statement informing this court of its purge by August 31, 2020." The June 30, 2020, Order also directed the Board to "provide an accounting of its cost and attorneys' fees incurred in this proceeding by July 15, 2020. On July 14, 2020, the Board filed its Application for Attorney Fees in the amount of \$1,395.00. On September 1, 2020, having not

received a sworn statement from Respondent that it had purged itself of contempt in accordance with this Court's June 30 Order, this court issued its case closing order stating, "Herewith is the final order of this court in this matter, along with the Bill of Costs, if any. This court's order is final and this case is closed in this court." On September 8, 2020, this Court granted the Board's Application for attorney fees in the amount of \$1,395.00.

Accordingly, because Respondent has failed to purge itself of contempt, it is therefore **ORDERED** that Respondent Perkins Management Services Company shall immediately pay to the Board a fine of \$20,000, plus the Board's attorney fees, for the total sum of \$21,395.00.
