Dear Judge Waldor:

Currently pending before this Court is the National Labor Relation Board's (Board) Renewed Motion for Adjudication in Civil Contempt and for Other Civil Relief (ECF No. 17), which seeks, *inter alia*, the issuance of Writs of Body Attachment against Respondents James Reid and Eric Reid. On March 2, 2020, the Board filed a letter (ECF No. 18) informing this Court of its withdrawal of the request for contempt relief against Respondent Eric Reid. On September 2, 2020, the Board filed a motion to withdraw without prejudice the entire contempt motion (ECF No. 19).

Although Respondents J.H. Reid General Contractor, James Reid, and Eric Reid have all failed to comply with the Board's subpoenas, which Judge Salas enforced, the Board believes that this entire case can be closed. After deposing James in November 2019, the Board discovered facts leading it to believe that it is unlikely to further pursue the investigation to which the subpoenas relate. Unless circumstances change, little would be gained by holding any of the Respondents in contempt of Judge Salas's enforcement order (ECF No. 11). And if circumstances do change, the Board will take appropriate action. But because this seems unlikely, this case can be closed in the interests of judicial economy.
