ORDER ENFORCING SUBPOENA

Applicant National Labor Relations Board, an administrative agency of the Federal Government, having filed and properly served its Application for Order Enforcing Administrative Subpoena Duces Tecum, and good cause appearing for the Application to be granted, it is hereby

ORDERED that NLRB subpoena duces tecum B-1-16SCLHB is enforced in its entirety, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall, within fourteen calendar days of the date of this order, produce all documents in full compliance with NLRB subpoena duces tecum B-1-16SCLHB, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall serve copies of this Order on Respondent by certified mail, return receipt requested, or overnight delivery service to Respondent's business address within three calendar days of the date of this Order, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall file proofs of service of this Order within seven calendar days of the date of this Order, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that within fourteen calendar days of the date of this order, the Applicant shall file a bill of costs (AO-133) with this Court if any taxable costs are claimed, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that within fourteen calendar days of the date of this order, the Applicant shall file and serve upon the Respondent an itemized statement of attorney fees incurred in connection with this Application, to include the date services were performed, the hourly rate claimed, and the work performed, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that within fourteen calendar days of the date of filing of the bills of costs and attorney fees, the Respondent shall serve any objections to those documents. Any items not specifically objected to shall be deemed conceded, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that within seven calendar days of the filing of objections to the Applicant's bills of costs and attorney fees, the Applicant may, but is not required to, file a reply in support of its bills.
