**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT’S MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE**

On January 6, 2021 Respondent filed a Motion for a continuance of the hearing in the above-captioned cases, currently scheduled to resume on January 11, 2021, in light of the current emergency situation in Los Angeles County as the result of the COVID-19 pandemic. This emergency situation, inter alia, requires any individuals traveling into Los Angeles County to quarantine for 2 weeks prior to meeting or mingling with other persons, making it impossible to meet with witnesses or other essential persons for trial preparation. The General Counsel and the Charging Party Union do not oppose the continuance, and accordingly it is hereby GRANTED. The parties had previously agreed that the hearing in this matter would be held on February 1<sup>st</sup> through the 5<sup>th</sup>, and on February 9<sup>th</sup> through the 12<sup>th</sup>, and those dates will remain in effect until further notice. We will hold a conference call on the week of January 25<sup>th</sup>, the exact date to be later determined, to re-examine whether any further postponements will be necessary in light of the situation at that time.
