**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR A POSTPONEMENT  
OF THE COMPLIANCE SPECIFICATION HEARING**

On February 2, 2021, the Respondent (Michael Cetta, Inc., d/b/a Sparks Restaurant) moved to postpone the February 22 compliance specification hearing in the above matter due to medical exigencies faced by counsel for the Respondent. Counsel for the Respondent represents that his son has recently been diagnosed with cancer and would require initial and follow-up treatment for approximately 12 weeks, starting about February 9. Counsel has delayed his own medical spinal procedure to care for his son.

Counsel for the Respondent is requesting that the hearing be rescheduled to May 10, 2021. Union counsel opposes this motion and counsel for the General Counsel believes that a one-month postponement to March 22 is sufficient.

Upon review, the Respondent's motion is granted based upon the reasons set forth in the Respondent's motion. I would encourage the parties to continue their settlement discussions and maintain their contact with Judge Green, the settlement judge, in this compliance proceeding.
