The following pertains to the petitioner's record excerpts resubmitted to the Court on February 9, 2021.

The record excerpts remain insufficient for the following reasons and must be corrected within the next **14 days**:

- The size of the text on the front cover page and in the Table of Contents must be increased to 14-point or larger (See **FED. R. APP. P.** 32(a)(5)).

The certificate of service/proof of service on your proposed sufficient record excerpts **MUST** be dated on the actual date that service is being made. Also, if your record excerpts are sealed, this event automatically seals/restricts any attached documents, therefore, you may still use this event to submit a sufficient record excerpts.

Failure to timely docket the Proposed Sufficient Record Excerpts event may result in the dismissal of the petition for review pursuant to **5TH CIR. R.** 42.3.
