Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit:

The National Labor Relations Board (“the Board”), by its Assistant General Counsel, respectfully moves this Court for an additional 14-day extension of time, from February 26, 2021, to and including March 12, 2021, for filing the certified index to the record in the above matter, and shows:

1. On December 12, 2019, the Board issued its Order, which is reported at 368 NLRB No. 134.
2. On December 23, 2020, the Charging Parties, Fast Food Workers Committee and Service Employees International Union, CTW, CLC, et al., filed a

Petition for Review of the Board's Order. On December 29, 2020, the Court issued a scheduling order setting the due date for the certified index as February 12, 2021.

3. On February 12, 2021, the Board requested and was granted a 14-day extension, to February 26, 2021.

4. The Board is unable to file this record on time and seeks an additional 14-day extension.

5. Counsel for the Fast Food Workers Committee does not oppose this motion.
