JOINT PROPOSED FORMAT FOR ALLOCATION OF ORAL ARGUMENT TIME

To the Honorable, the Judges of the United States
Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit:

In response to the Court's February 24, 2021 order, the National Labor Relations Board, by its Assistant General Counsel, respectfully submits this joint proposed format for allocation of oral argument time on behalf of the parties. In support of this proposal, the Board shows as follows:

1. Oral argument is scheduled to be held on March 11, 2021 before Judges Pillard, Katsas, and Silberman.
2. Four organizations seek review of two Board decisions (369 NLRB No. 10 (2020) and 369 NLRB No. 11 (2020)) in this case: Stein, Inc.; International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 18; Truck Drivers, Chauffeurs, & Helpers, Local Union No. 100; and Laborers' International Union of North America, Local No. 534. Laborers' Local No. 534 also intervened on the Board's behalf but did not file an intervenor brief.
3. Given the two separate Board decisions before the panel, the lengthy records and the number of parties involved, as well as the multiple petitions for review, the parties respectfully propose that they proceed in the following order at argument, which mirrors the format of the parties' briefs:

Petitioners:

Stein, Inc.	15 minutes
Local 18	5 minutes
Local 100/Local 534	10 minutes (one counsel to argue)

Respondent:

NLRB	20 minutes
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Petitioners' Rebuttals

Stein	Time to be reserved from 15 min allocation
Local 18	Time to be reserved from 5 min allocation
Local 100/Local 534	Time to be reserved from 10 min allocation

4. Counsel for Stein, Local 18, Local 100, and Local 534 have authorized the Board to file this joint proposed argument format on their behalf.

WHEREFORE, the Board respectfully requests that the Court adopt the parties' joint proposed format for oral argument.
