AMENDED ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Michael H. Simon, District Judge.

The Amended Petition (ECF 21) of Ronald K. Hooks, Regional Director of Region 19 (the Region) of the National Labor Relations Board (the Board), having been filed pursuant to § 10(j) of the National Labor Relations Act, as amended, [61 Stat. 149; 73 Stat. 554; 29 U.S.C. § 160(j)], praying for issuance of a preliminary injunction against Hood River Distillers, Inc. (Respondent), and praying for issuance of an order directing Respondent to show cause as to why a preliminary injunction should not be granted as prayed for in the Amended Petition, the Amended Petition being verified, and to be supported by affidavit testimony and evidence, and good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that *amici*, including The Board of Trustees of the Oregon Processors Employees Trust Fund and the Teamster Food Processors, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen, and Helpers, Local Union No. 670, shall file their briefs in support of the Amended Petition with the

Clerk of this Court, together with any affidavits, declarations, and exhibits, on or before the 15th day of March, 2021, by 5:00 p.m.; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall file an Answer to the allegations of the Amended Petition with the Clerk of this Court, together with any affidavits, declarations, and exhibits in support of said Answer, and serve a copy thereof upon Petitioner at his office located at 2948 Jackson Federal Building, 915 Second Avenue, Seattle, WA 98174, on or before the 22nd day of March, 2021, by 5:00 p.m.; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner may file and serve a reply brief along with rebuttal affidavits, declarations, and exhibits on or before the 29th day of March, 2021, by 5:00 p.m.; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall appear before this Court, through videoconference before the Honorable Michael H. Simon, on the 2nd day of April, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, and then and there show cause, if any there be, why, pending the final disposition of the administrative proceedings set to be heard before an Administrative Law Judge of the Board, on May 25, 2021, and on consecutive days thereafter, in Cases 19-CA-260013, 19-CA-265595, 19-CA-267920, 19-CA-268290, and 19-CA-264083, a preliminary injunction should not issue enjoining and restraining Respondent, its officers, representatives, supervisors, agents, employees, attorneys and all persons acting on its behalf or in participation with it, under § 10(j) of the Act as prayed for in the Amended Petition.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
