Petitioner must submit the 4 paper copies of your record excerpts required by 5TH Cir. R. 30.1.2 within 5 days of the date of this notice pursuant to 5th Cir. ECF Filing Standard E.1. Exception: As of July 2, 2018, record excerpts filed in relation to Anders briefs only require 2 paper copies. **We remind attorneys that the paper copies of record excerpts filed with the court must contain physical tabs that extend beyond the edge of the document to facilitate easy identification and review of tabbed documents.** See 5TH Cir. R. 30.1.7(c).

Failure to timely provide the appropriate number of copies may result in the dismissal of your petition pursuant to 5TH Cir. R. 42.3.

The paper copies of your brief/record excerpts must **not** contain a header noting "RESTRICTED". Therefore, please be sure that you print your paper copies from the notice of docket activity and not the proposed sufficient brief/record excerpts filed event so that it will contain the proper filing header. Alternatively, you may print the sufficient brief/record excerpts directly from your original file without any header.
