ACTING GENERAL COUNSEL’S RESPONSE TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Counsel for the Acting General Counsel (Acting General Counsel) files this Response to the Order to Show Cause issued by Associate Chief Administrative Law Judge Gerald M. Etchingham on March 17, 2021.¹ For the reason set forth below, Acting General Counsel opposes Respondent’s Motion to Reschedule Hearing (Respondent’s Motion) insofar as Respondent seeks to postpone the hearing, currently scheduled for March 23, for a “minimum of 60 days.” Respondent’s Motion, page 3.

Respondent requests that the hearing be postponed for a minimum of 60 days due to the unavailability of a witness, Kevin Million (Million). However, Respondent fails to articulate a legitimate reason as to why the hearing should be delayed for at least 60 days. Respondent avers that Million will be absent through the end of March, but neglects to indicate an approximate return to work date for Million. Thus, Respondent arbitrarily selected 60 days as the minimum amount of time that this hearing, which is scheduled to last no more than two days, should be postponed. Accordingly, the
